10 WORKS UNDER \$10,000 TO BUY AT UNTITLED SAN FRANCISCO

For its third iteration as a Bay Area art fair, UNTITLED returns to San Francisco with the same “something for everyone” approach to its holdings. While FOG, the locally born, blue-chip fair carries hefty price tags, the works at UNTITLED are decidedly more approachable for the up-and-coming collector. Below, spanning lithographs and polaroids of major artists and full-bodied works by the more emerging and mid-career, are 10 of our favorite works that ring up at \$10,000 or below.

Trish Tillman's Nightglow, 2019, \$3,500

Tillman's sculptures look strikingly familiar, like ancient suits of armor or tribal masks flattened and mounted to the wall. The works' very contemporary air comes from her use of neon-colored vinyls, allusions to body piercings and chains and the occasional mane of blond hair, seen here almost as a provocation—almost like a pointed tongue from a pair of red lips.
