NADA ANNOUNCES NEW INITIATIVE FOR 2019 ARMORY WEEK

The New Art Dealers Alliance (NADA) plans to introduce a new initiative during New York's upcoming Armory week. Rather than hold a 2019 fair, NADA announced last August that it would instead dedicate more resources to New York galleries. From March 4 to March 10, the nonprofit will present the New York Gallery Open, created to bring visitors, collectors, curators, and critics to over fifty galleries, nonprofits, and alternative spaces around New York City.

"In some ways, New York functions like a year-round art fair," said NADA executive director Heather Hubbs. "Galleries host exhibitions which are open and accessible to the public all year. With the New York Gallery Open, we're placing the focus on gallery exhibitions in their spaces across the city during the March Art Week. It's in these essential places where galleries develop their programs."

Participants in the New York Gallery Open will hold guided tours, artist talks, performances, dinners, and VIP events. In order to cultivate a renewed sense of energy, viewership, and patronage within these spaces, NADA has partnered with Collecteurs, a collector-driven online platform and public-benefit corporation, which will create a dedicated hub for the public to view artworks and editorial features about the galleries.

In addition to the New York-based galleries participating in the New York Gallery Open, NADA members from other cities will also take part in the event. Shane Campbell Gallery (Chicago), Golestani (Dusseldorf), and L'INCONNUE (Montreal) will exhibit works across two ON CANAL spaces at 359 and 361 Canal Street; seven out-of-town galleries, including Good Weather (North Little Rock), LOYAL (Stockholm), and Franz Kaka (Toronto), will organize shows at Jack Barrett on 173 Henry Street; Patron (Chicago) will stage an exhibition at 213 Bowery; and ltd los angeles (Los Angeles) will present works at 24A Orchard Street as part of the gallery share Vacation.
